The Council meets every month, on the second calendar Wednesday of the month, at the Village Hall, commencing at 7.30 pm. Agendas are published a week before and are on our website. Members of the public are welcome to come along and attend.

The Council met in October and also had two meetings in November—one full Council meeting as usually scheduled and then a planning meeting to consider two extra planning applications which needed to be considered before the December meeting.

Various planning applications were discussed and all planning applications discussed at the PC meetings are available to view on the NELC website at www.nelincs.gov.uk. You just go to the Planning Applications, agree the terms and conditions and then you can input the planning application reference number or the address and it will bring up the documents for you to view.

The Members were present at the Remembrance Day Service on Remembrance Sunday and afterwards hosted residents back at the Village Hall for some light refreshments. A big thank you to the WI members who helped with the refreshments.

Members have also attended other various meetings such as the Shaping Up Stallingborough Group and the Town and Parish Liaison Committee and the BCCRP meetings.

The Council is also formalising the arrangements with its allotment site and starting a new waiting list for those interested in taking an allotment and confirming insurance arrangements for those on the site.

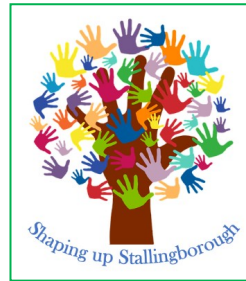

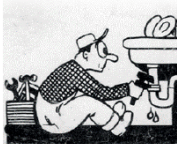

Phone and Ride Update:

In June 2021, the Phone n Ride service worked in partnership with Stallingborough Parish Council to deliver a consultation with Stallingborough residents regarding the lack of regular transport. The consultation identified a need for a regular Tuesday semi-fixed return journey from Stallingborough to Grimsby Town Centre via Morrisons supermarket. Initially the semi-fixed route was well used but there has been an ongoing decline in passenger journeys to the point where the semi-fixed route has only provided three passenger journeys since August 2023 despite regular promotion of the service in the local Parish Council newsletter and via leaflet drops. Current Phone n Ride passenger bookings have been analysed and it has been identified that Stallingborough residents have been booking the Phone n Ride service individually to travel to other destinations such as Immingham, travelling directly to Grimsby Town Centre from Stallingborough and travelling on different days of the week to the current semi-fixed route service. This has in turn led to the reduction in demand for the semi-fixed service on a Tuesday.

Recommendation: It is recommended the Phone n Ride Stallingborough semi-fixed route is withdrawn due to the reduction in usage since May 2023 and the low passenger numbers currently being experienced on the service.
